Top five topics for enquiries to PST across England

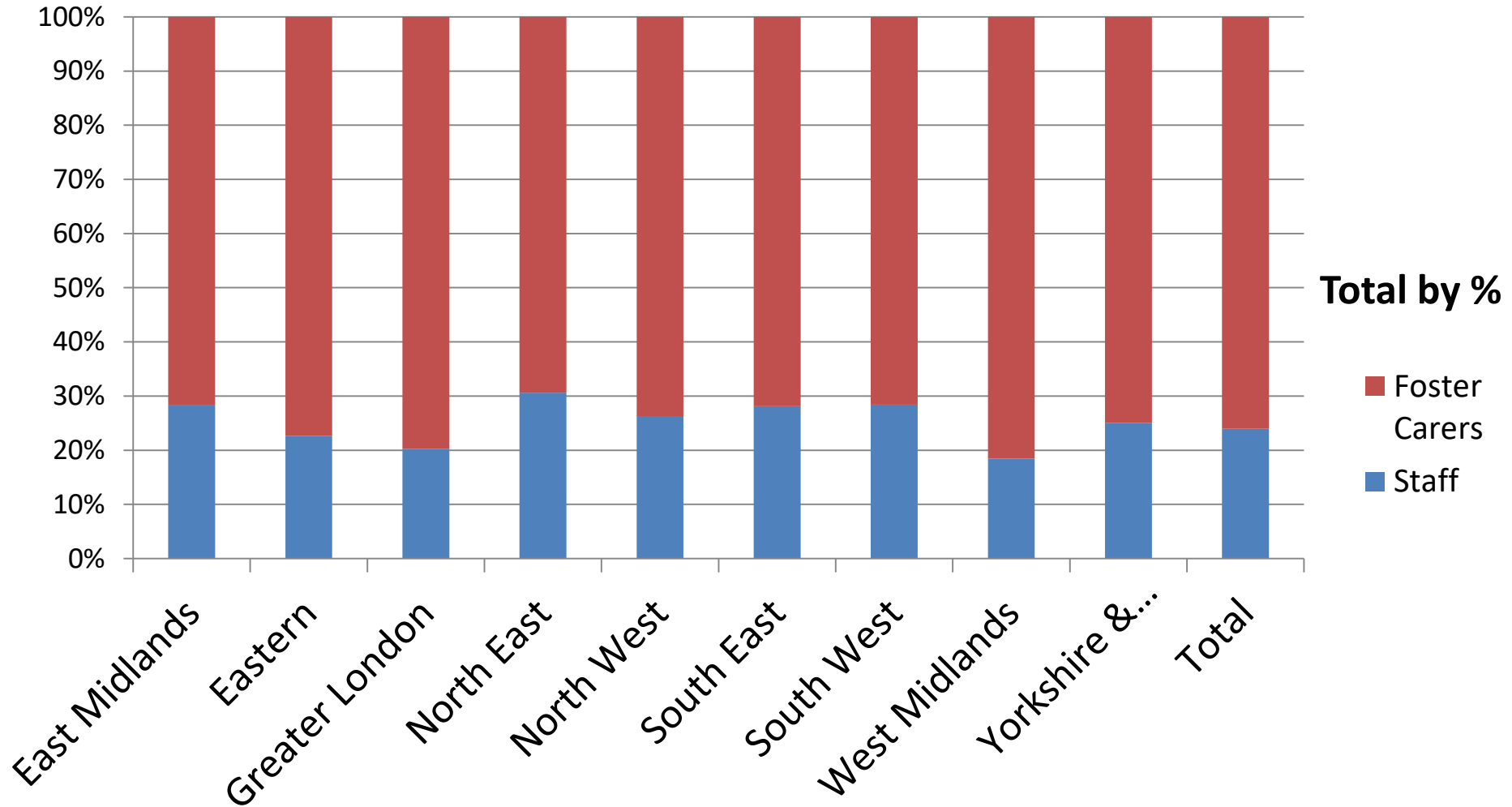
- Family and friends carers/connected persons
- Approval and assessment of foster carers
- Legislation, regulations and guidance
- Fostering Panels
- Record keeping

Top five members' helpline topics over the last year

3059 helpline enquires (01.10.2017- 30.09.2018)

- Financial issues – **721 = 24%**
- Allegations and standard of care concerns – **250 = 8%** (194/56)
- Review of approval -**104 = 3%**
- Disruption of placement – **75 = 2%**
- Record keeping and data protection **73 = 2%**

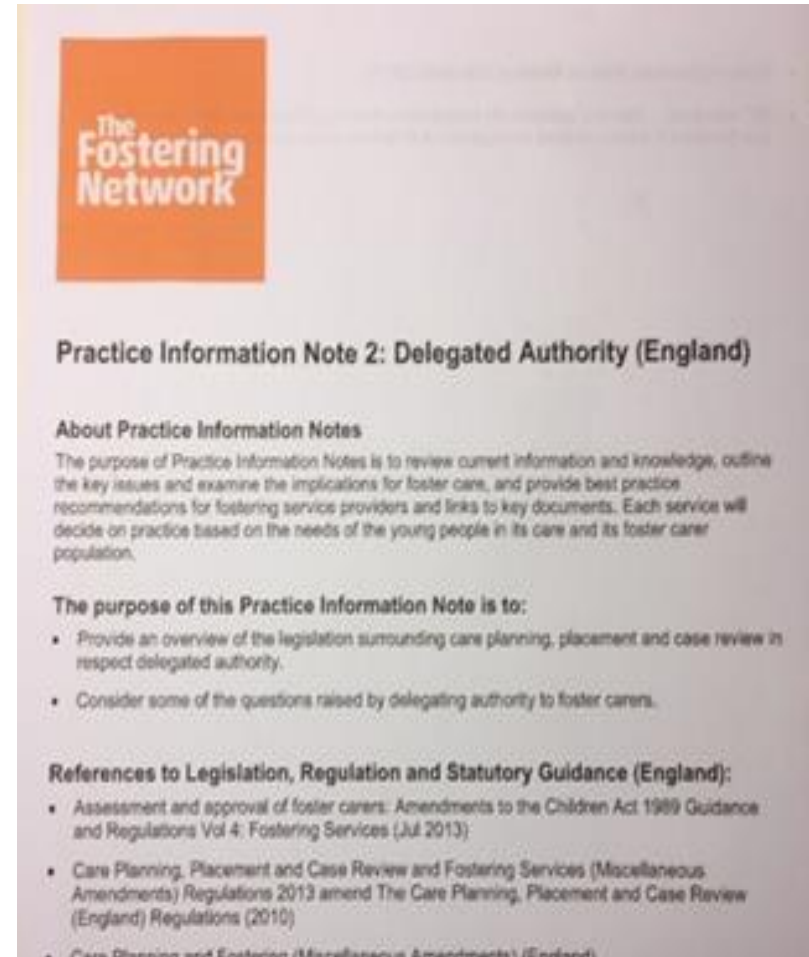
We consult with you and represent your views to a range of key national steering groups as well as organisations such as the Department for Education and Ofsted.

- Smoking and e cigarettes

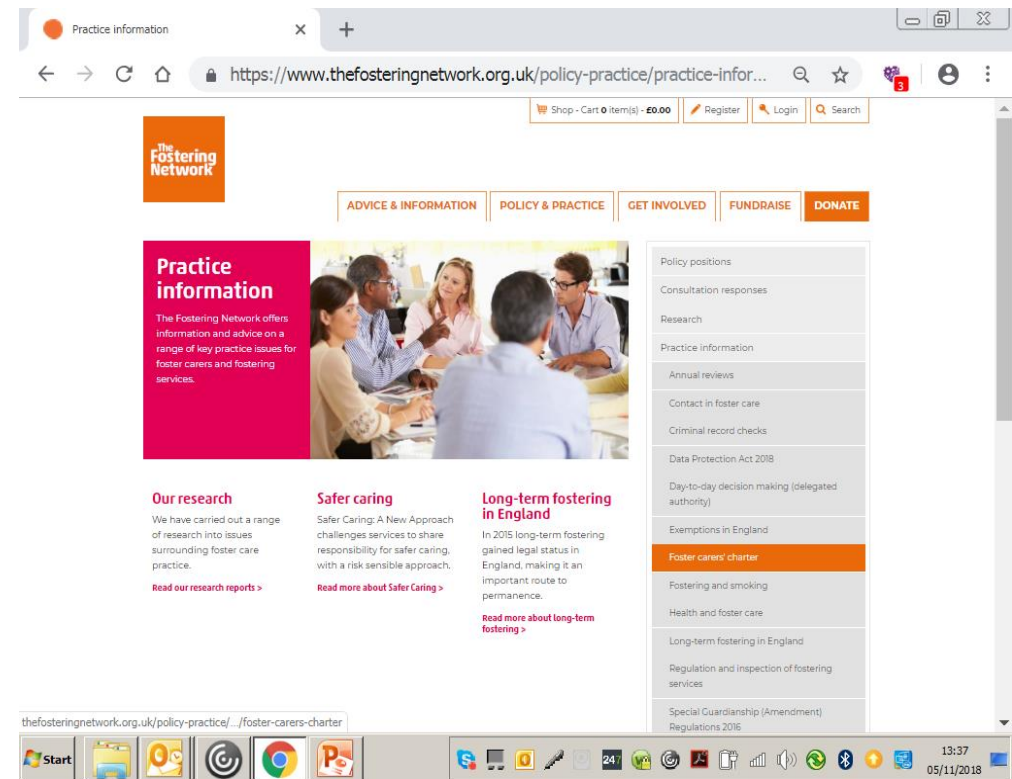


Webpage development
