- Record keeping




Top five members' helpline topics over the last year

3059 helpline enquires (01.10.2017- 30.09.2018)

- Financial issues **721 = 24%**
- Allegations and standard of care concerns 250 = 8% (194/56)
- Review of approval -104 = 3%
- Disruption of placement 75 = 2%
- Record keeping and data protection **73 = 2%**

We consult with you and represent your views to a range of key national steering groups as well as organisations such as the Department for Education and Ofsted.






Practice Information

- Smoking and e cigarettes






Webpage development
